Beauty Therapy Diploma Course - CIDESCO

The CIDESCO Course is for those who wish to study Beauty and Aesthetic Treatments for the Face and Body Therapy to the highest standards achievable in Beauty Therapy.

The CIDESCO International Beauty Therapy Diploma is a prestigious and highly recognised qualification worldwide. Upon completion of your studies, you will be entered for your examination with CIDESCO, after graduating you will be required to complete 600 hours of work in a salon or spa to obtain the highly accredited CIDESCO International Beauty Therapy Diploma.

CIDESCO Course Structure

The CIDESCO programme is split into two qualifications: CIDESCO Aesthetics Diploma (with Advanced Skin, Microneedling or Chemical Peels) and CIDESCO Body Therapy Diploma.

The CIDESCO Day Course runs from October to June (8 months). Students begin their training with the CIDESCO Aesthetics module on Mondays. CIDESCO Body Therapy module commences in March. The CIDESCO examinations are held in June.

All our courses are now offered in modular format with Blended eLearning, students attend College for face-to-face practical protocols with Live Tutorial Lectures and our own Practical videos available online on the student eLearning Zone.

We have also added an on-line Level 3 Anatomy & Physiology Module to all facial skincare courses, offering fully blended learning, and allowing you to study in your own home at a time that suits you. Initially students will have the opportunity to work on the Mannequin Head to perfect practical protocols. The college can provide models for our practical classes, and students can bring in friends and family to ensure you are more commercially ready to work in the beauty industry.

A Tilly Head Mannequin for home and zoom practice is essential requirement for the course (cost £150.00 paid directly to the school for the use of the Tilly Head for the duration of the course. The Tilly Head must be returned at the end of the course.

Practical experience is an essential part of the course, the college school salon enables students to gain invaluable experience and gain confidence, providing the opportunity to work on a wide range of skin types, conditions and lifestyle factors that influence and affect skin health will help students develop strong consultation skills.

Students will need access to an iPad, Laptop or Computer plus a printer for the duration of the course.

Each student is responsible for their own model for mock and actual exams. These models must be fully pre-cleared for COVID compliance.
